Thank you for filling out these documents to apply for scholarship financial aid to participate in the Ikaika Hawaii Waterman's Program. IKAIKA HAWAII endeavors to help develop our Hawaii keiki into inspirational Watermen & Olympic Champions!

Scholarship Criteria

- 1. Athlete must show potential to perform to the best of their athletic ability in water sports, per coach's discretion, and be able to consistently participate in the Program's scheduled sessions.
- 2. Athlete must demonstrate good character, leadership qualities and the ability to contribute to Ikaika Hawaii to represent Oahu, Hawaii and the USA. (positive example, good role model, excellent sportsmanship)
- 3. Athlete must demonstrate financial need.
- 4. Athlete must have a GPA of 2.5, based on a 4.0 scale.
- 5. Athlete should be a team player (help with gear, help others improve) and show a commitment to excellence (put in extra work, strive to be prepared, show dedication to personal and team accomplishments).

The recipient may or may not be the best athlete, but has shown exceptional enthusiasm, participation, effort, spirit and dedication to warrant this special recognition in the opinion of the Ikaika Hawaii Scholarship Committee. Financial aid, which will be considered based upon the above criteria, as well as availability of funds, is merit and need based.

The Ikaika Hawaii Scholarship Committee consists of the Head Coach and selected active members of the Ikaika Board of Directors. Scholarship applications are accepted on a rolling basis throughout the year and will be kept on file for future consideration as the Ikaika Hawaii Scholarship Committee sees fit. All decisions by the Committee are final; however, applicants may request to be reconsidered if unsuccessful initially, or considered for reinstatement if support given was later rescinded. If deemed appropriate by the Committee, scholarships are renewable from month to month, session to session, or annually.

In regard to financial need, Ikaika Hawaii considers that both parents have an obligation to contribute to the extent they can to their children's athletic endeavors and future dreams. Both natural parents (and their current spouse/s) will be considered in terms of financial need assessment. Basic trust and honesty is expected by the Ikaika Hawaii Scholarship Committee from the applicant and family members. The committee needs to be made aware of any changes in the family's financial issues should they occur.

Documents to apply consist of : **1.** The complete application filled out by the athlete, and signed by both the athlete and a parent/guardian if under age 21. **2**. A 300 word essay written in its entirety by the athlete. Both the application and the essay must be turned in at the same time to the Head Coach for consideration by the Committee.
